The Staff Makes the Difference in PVRC Rehab Department

Compliments are common when Palm Village residents speak of the special relationships they have with their Rehab therapists.

As a 'Continuing Care' facility, Palm Village is able to provide many levels of health care to treat residents as their individual health needs change. This "continuum of care" is critical to providing a high quality of life, and our Rehabilitation Department is at the very heart of this system.

Rehab Director Dora Provencio leads a licensed and highly-trained staff of up to 12 professionals who have one goal in mind – to return each patient to their prior level of functionality in the shortest amount of time. "We start looking at their prior level of function from the day they arrive," Provencio said, "it's important for both the therapist and patient that we get them back to prior levels of mobility as soon as we can."

The three different levels of residency at Palm Village work together in the continuing care environment, and the rehab Department is the catalyst that keeps the system working. Provencio cited the case of Eleanor Boettcher a current RCC Resident who has

been a rehab patient on different occasions. "Eleanor has been back to our department three times," explains Provencio, "and each time we returned her to an Independent Living lifestyle."

Boettcher's recent comments about her therapy in the Rehab Department confirm the wonderful work that Provencio's staff does, and also shed light on a reason why many area Hospital Discharge Planners

have acknowledged the department's high success rate.

"They helped me do my exercises, and I couldn't even walk before therapy began, said Boettcher. "I am very satisfied with the way I was treated, and now I can walk with a walker. My Therapists were nice and friendly, they were sweet and encouraged me, they even gave me hugs! My niece has visited many Rehab centers and says that Palm Village's is the best one she has ever seen."

The secret to the Rehab Department's success is the people they hire, reports Provencio. "When we are hiring, we look for people who are compassionate – we need to hire people who really care about their patients. Sometimes it can be quite humiliating for a patient to not be able to take care of their own hygiene needs. We look for people who will let that patient know it's going to be O.K." The department's dedicated staff on any given day will include 4-5 licensed Physical Therapists, 3-4 full-time

licensed and registered Occupational Therapists, one Speech Language Pathologist, and several Certified Therapy Assistants.

Provencio adds that besides having a compassionate staff, one of the other keys to a successful department is communications. “Before we begin treatment, we meet with the nursing staff and administrators to learn all the background information on that patient.

When a therapist possesses a long history on a particular patient, good results can happen quicker, says Provencio. “Knowledge of the patient is critical to a speedy recovery. Because PRVC therapists work with the patient from start to finish, there are no steps backwards, all steps are forward.”

This is not always the case in a nursing situation that does not offer continuing care. “Typically a patient living in their own home may enter a skilled

nursing facility, and after rehabilitation, be returned to their home, explains Provencio. “Even if home health care is available, it will not be provided by the same health care professionals that treated that patient in rehab. But at PVRC, the same therapists work with that patient all the way through.”

The goal of providing a high quality of life extends past the patient to their family as well. When Rehab can treat the patient and get them back to the prior level of mobility, the patient feels better, but the family can also rest easier.

Everything that Palm Village’s Rehabilitation Department does is based around the simple belief that patients in their 70s, 80s and 90s are still interested in maintaining a life filled with happiness. And just because someone has reached a certain age,

says Provencio, it doesn’t mean they don’t have lots of living left to do.

“We want the same thing that our patients want, and that’s for them to live free of the burdens of diminished health. We’re all aiming in the same direction, which is why we so often achieve our goals.”

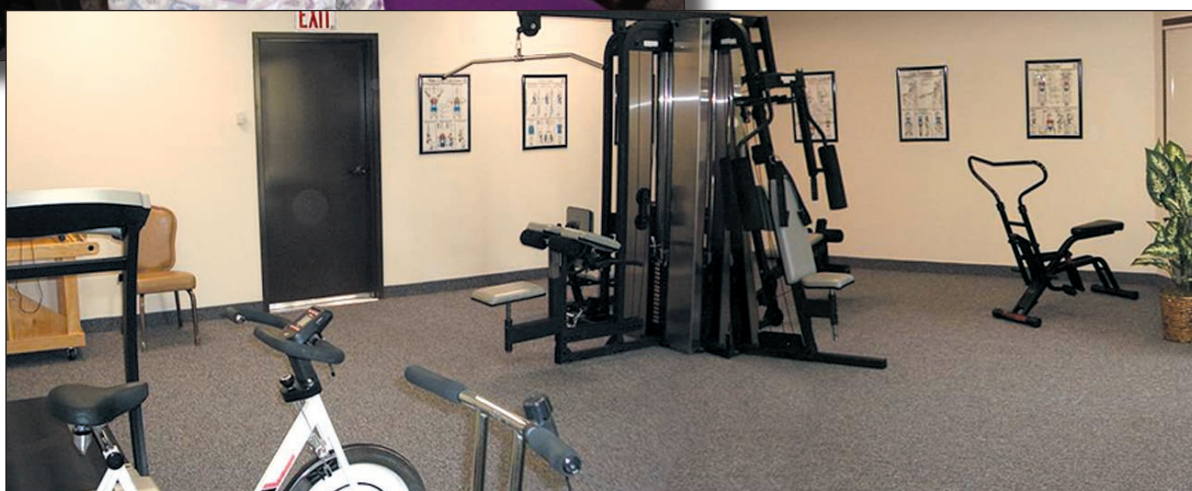
